Please reflect and compose a 250-500 word essay on ONE of the following prompts:

Prompt One: (for students with theatre/performing arts experience including but not limited to: musical theatre, drama, production, dance, vocal, or instrumental performance)

Explain how your involvement in theatre/performing arts has made an active change in your life both internally and externally. What have you taken from your experiences, how has it impacted your faith, and what have you given as a result of your experiences? How has this involvement “made a difference” in your life?

Prompt Two: (for students with limited or no theatre/performing arts experience)

Explain how theatre/performing arts could make a positive impact on your life in high school, and how will you use this unique experience to make a positive impact on others and enable you to live your faith? How will it empower you to “make a difference” in your school community?

Prompt Three: (for students with or without theatre/performing arts experience)

Explain how theatre/performing arts can create opportunities to make communities: foster healthy relationships, celebrate the common human experience, and engage in important social issues? How can theatre/performing arts be used to spread good messages concerning faith and allow you to personally “make a difference” in the world?

CRITERIA FOR CONSIDERATION

- Applicants must have a completed Donovan Catholic Application for Admission on file.
- Applicants must be in good academic standing.
- Applicants must submit the following in a manila envelope with his/her name on the front:
 - A completed Performing Arts Scholarship application
 - Two letters of recommendation
 - Two copies of your essay typed and double spaced.
- **Applications received after November 16, 2020, will not be accepted.**
- Finalists for this scholarship will be notified by e-mail

Please note that this is a renewable scholarship for up to four years

Renewal Criteria

- **Recipient must remain in good academic and disciplinary standing.**
- **Recipient must participate in at least two theatre productions each year.**
- **Recipient must write a reflection essay each year. (Topic and due date to be announced annually.)**
